

CASTLEHILL WOODS PATHWAY

This Community Council (CC) have been campaigning for cash to restore the paths in Castlehill Woods. This CC can gain access to funds that South Ayrshire Council cannot. We have secured funding of £2400 and have now resurfaced a good portion of a one-kilometre circuit around your neighbourhood. But we need to finish the resurfacing behind the houses from 52 to 26 Roman Road. This strip of land is privately owned but we have the owner's permission to resurface these paths.

We'd like to off load 20 tons of 'Type 1 Sub Base' material on the road adjacent to lamp post No R25 at the top of Roman Road. This should happen over the next couple of weeks. Then, using diggers, dumpers and volunteers spread this material along the path and get this compacted ready for use. It's likely we might need a second 20 ton too. If you wish to help, please keep informed through our Web and Facebook pages.

We appreciate that this is an inconvenience to you and your household, but we will do this work as quickly as we can and make sure that the street is left as it should be. We do not anticipate the pavements to be blocked and every home's access will be clear.

This community council want the paths to be good for use by all the folk around. We want to see walkers, dogs and runners, grannies and weans on wee bikes, young mothers with buggies having a good solid, flat surface that's puddle free to encourage folk to get out and enjoy the park. Look for the Sequoias, the Tulip Tree and the Indian Chestnut.

If you're unhappy with our plan, please get back to us to discuss if there's an alternate solution.
